<p><b>Course Description:</b></p> <p>Serves as the clinical experience to coincide with EMS 125. This course allows the student to practice skills in clinical settings to include the emergency department and ambulance services.</p> <p>The EMT-B typically provides prehospital care in a wide variety of circumstances. This course offers basic training in all aspects of emergency medical care in the EMT-Basic scope of practice. The EMT-B is prepared to administer basic life support to victims of emergencies, minimize further patient injury, and reduce recuperative time.</p>				
<p><b>Prerequisite(s):</b></p> <p>18 years of age, criminal background check, CPT testing (score of 80 or above), application fee, signed <i>Statement of Receipt</i> , proof of vaccinations: chicken pox, tetanus, PPD, MMR, proof of first Hep-B, BLS card, Social Security card, HS Diploma or GED.</p>

**Grading Policy:**

Clinical rotations are evaluated on a pass/fail basis.

**Attendance Policy:**

If a student is unable to attend an assigned shift, either clinical or field rotation, it is the student's responsibility to notify the clinical area and the Course Coordinator. A \$50.00 rescheduling fee will be assessed per shift and must be paid prior to rescheduling. If the following criteria is met, a rescheduling fee will not be charged but the shift is still noted as a missed shift:

- a. Death in the family with submission of a memorial card
- b. Illness with a written doctor's excuse
- c. Illness of significant other/child with written doctor's excuse

Each student is limited to two (2) rescheduled shifts, more than two (2) will be cause for dismissal from the program. Only one rescheduled shift is allowed if appropriate phone calls to clinical sites are not made at the time of an absence.
