

BLEEDING CONTROL/SHOCK MANAGEMENT

STEPS TO BE PERFORMED	ACTION/VERBAL RESPONSE	POINTS POSSIBLE	POINTS AWARDED
* Takes appropriate body substance isolation precautions	I will take appropriate BSI precautions.	(1)	
* Applies direct pressure to wound	Using an appropriate dressing I am applying direct pressure to the wound.	(1)	
The Examiner states: <i>The wound continues to bleed.</i>			
* Apply a tourniquet	I will apply a tourniquet just proximal to the wound and tighten until the bleeding stops	(1)	
The Examiner states: <i>The bleeding is now controlled. The patient is showing signs and symptoms of shock (hypoperfusion).</i>			
Properly positions the patient	I will lie the patient down with feet elevated.	(1)	
Initiates appropriate oxygen therapy	I will place the patient on supplemental oxygen.	(1)	
Initiates steps to prevent heat loss from the patient	I will cover the patient with a blanket to preserve heat.	(1)	
* Indicates need for immediate transportation	I will categorize this patient as high priority for transport.	(1)
