

## Skill Sheet Oral Glucose

Skill	Pass	Needs Improvement (Please comment)
1. Takes or verbalizes body substance isolation precautions.		
2. Performs initial assessment.		
3. Performs focused assessment and physical exam.		
4. Verbalizes indications: (patient with altered mental status with known history of diabetes controlled by medication).		
5. Verbalizes contraindications: (altered mental status - UNRESPONSIVE, & unable to swallow).		
6. Obtains direct medical order via radio or telephone.		
7. Administers medication, instructs patient to swallow medication.		
8. Verbalizes documentation of time, dose, response, and MD giving the order.		
9. Initiates transport (as indicated).		

### Critical Criteria

- \_\_\_ Did not take/verbalize B.S.I.
- \_\_\_ Unable to recite indications
- \_\_\_ Unable to recite contraindications
- \_\_\_ Did not obtain on-line medical control
- \_\_\_ Administers medication in improper manner
