Oxygen-Powered Device

Skill	Pass	Needs Improvement (Please comment)
1. Takes or verbalizes body substance isolation precautions.		
2. Opens patient's airway. (head tilt/chin lift or jaw thrust)		
3. Inserts an airway adjunct.		
4. Selects appropriately sized mask.		
5. Creates a proper mask-to-face seal.		
6. Ventilates patient at adequate tidal volume and rate. (The examiner must witness for at least 30 seconds)		
7. The examiner indicates arrival of a second EMT. The second EMT is instructed to ventilate the patient while the candidate controls the mask and the airway.		
8. Re-opens the airway.		
9. Creates a proper mask-to-face seal.		
10. Instructs assistant to resume ventilation at proper volume per breath. (The examiner must witness for at least 30 seconds)		

Critical Criteria

- _____ Did not take, or verbalize, body substance isolation precautions
- _____ Interrupted ventilations for more than 20 seconds
- _____ Did not provide, or direct assistant to provide, proper volume/ breath (more than 2 ventilations per minute are below 800 ml)
- _____ Did not allow adequate time for exhalation
- _____ Did not ventilate at a rate of 12 breaths per minute.
