Course Description:

The ALS National Registry exam is for EMT Intermediates (85), EMT Intermediates (99) and EMT Paramedics. The exam is hosted by HealthONE EMS. A representative of National Registry administers the exam. The exam consists of two parts.

The practical exam consists of skills presented in a scenario-type format to assess the abilities of the ALS provider to function in the out-of-hospital setting. All skills have been developed in accordance with the National Standard Curriculum. The general areas evaluated are listed below. Specific skills in each area are based on the student's level of education and certification.

1. Patient assessment
2. Airway management
3. Cardiac management
4. IV and drug therapy
5. Pediatric care
6. Oral station (EMT paramedic only)
7. Random basic skill
 8. Spinal immobilization seated
 9. Spinal immobilization supine
10. Bleeding control / shock management

Objectives:

To inventory the ALS provider's knowledge and skill proficiency at their level of their certification

CEUs: none given for the exam

Required information:

Students must be within two (2) years of their primary course or refresher course to be eligible to take this exam.



Students are required to establish their eligibility to take this exam with the National Registry office. HealthONE EMS does not determine eligibility.

The student must register with the National Registry office **and** the HealthONE EMS office. There are two separate registration fees. One is paid to the National Registry office and one is paid to HealthONE EMS.

National Registry application forms must be obtained through the NR office and mailed to National Registry directly. **Do not bring completed applications to the test site.**
